Thank you for your attention to my resume. My name is Jia Xi (JC) and I am a teaching dance artist with over 10 years of experience in dance education and performance, specialising in classical ballet and contemporary dance.

In recent years (2021-2023) I have taught full-time at the Singapore Ballet Academy, an associate school with the Singapore Ballet, and School of the Arts, Singapore, an IB World School where I taught students across the ages of 6-18 at recreational and professional level. With my familiarity with the aim of IB's learner profile, I look forward to support your students through my dance programme to encourage development of learners who are: inquirer, knowledgeable, thinkers, communicators, principled, open-minded, caring, risk-takers, balanced, and reflective.

My performing career started with the Royal New Zealand Ballet and Singapore Dance Theatre (currently known as Singapore Ballet) upon graduation with a Diploma in Dance Performance awarded by the New Zealand School of Dance. I was the first dance artist to be nominated twice in a year (2020) for my performance in collaboration with multidisciplinary artists, and I won the Best Featured Lead Performer at the national arts award in Malaysia. I now hold a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology and Communication Arts with first-class honours awarded by Troy University, Al., US, and am currently at the final leg of my Master's Degree in Applied Neuroscience with King's College London to be completed in Sep 2024.

With my knowledge in neuroscience, psychology, and yoga, as a dance educator, my classes are not limited to movement and steps, but also the motivation and science behind the mind that creates those movements. I seek to create values with my students through the discipline in the classical ballet tradition which I am passionate to share with my colleagues, and was awarded funding to run a skills lab in Malaysia specifically for teachers based on the framework of psychology: the biopsychosocial approach to dance practice.

In alignment with my work and approach, under a full bursary award, I am officially an affiliate teacher of the Royal Ballet School of London, fully qualified to deliver their holistic dance programme, Affiliate Training and Assessment Programme (ATAP) that celebrates students of all backgrounds, learning abilities, and body types. It would be an honour for me to offer ATAP to your students aged 5 and above "to learn about dance as a whole, including choreography, repertoire, and appreciation. The method is rooted in the latest pedagogical thinking and focuses on guiding children 'how' to learn, not to learn exercises by rote."
